



Management of Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) in Primary Health Care Facilities

MH/EVD/PHC/V.1.21.8.14

Follow these instructions once a case is suspected in a **Primary Health Care setting** (refer to case definition in MH/EVD/R&I algorithm ver. 1.0)

1. Immediately isolate the patient in a single room with adequate ventilation
2. Do not handle the patient without PPE
3. Do not perform any procedures or collect any samples from the patient
4. Always apply frequent hand hygiene
5. Inform the regional hospital and the National **EOC (Hotline 9853 0960)**
6. The patient must be transferred to the regional hospital immediately
7. The escort staff and ambulance driver must wear PPE
8. Inform immediately to:

- a. **MOIC**
- b. **Wilayat Director**
- c. **Director of Health Affairs, DGHS**
- d. **Director General of Health Services**

If the patient is **unstable** (signs of shock)

1. Resuscitate the patient in the isolation room
2. No intubation or blood collection should be done in primary health care
3. Follow steps from 2 to 8
