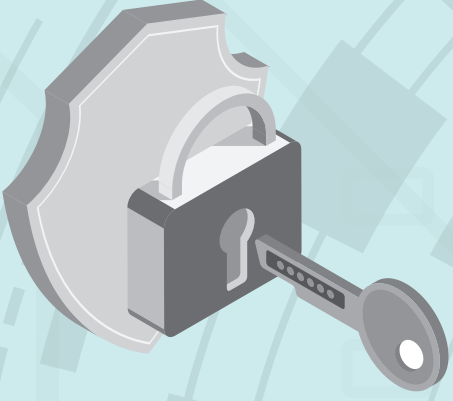


PERSONAL SECURITY
